This is the del segno sign. Used with the instruction **D.S.** Commonly called the 'dumb sign' as the initials are the same and will help people remember the meaning. When you get to the end of a song, if there is a D.S. written, pop back up to this sign and complete the song.

{FINE} Finish. If we go back to an earlier part in the song to repeat, like a D.S., when you see a FINE in brackets, that is the ending the second time through the section

N.C. This means No Chord. You will start strumming at the next chord you see.

When you see this symbol beside a chord, it means that you roll down the strings - arpeggiate the chord.

/ This means to stop playing or play just one strum on that chord.

is When a word is underlined, it falls on the beat and words before it are a pick-up

This is a rest. This means you rest a beat for each one you see and refers to singing not strumming.

NOTE: Any chord that has extra numbers and letters after its name eg. Gsus4, can be altered to a more accessible chord. Start on the right and take away numbers and letters until you see a chord that you recognize. The only exception is a small 'm'. That makes the chord minor and cannot be changed without affecting the song. So, Gsus4 could be played as a G chord.

~This is a tremolo symbol.

When you see a chord symbol at the end of a line, it is an indication that you will do 3 or 4 more strums to complete the bar of music before moving to the next line.
